He completed the Graduate Diploma in Law (GDL) in 2011 and the Legal Practice Course (LPC) in 2012, both at BPP Law School in London. In 2019, having left Freshfields, Tom obtained a Distinction in the Bachelor of Civil Law (BCL) at Oxford.
